

## Schedule of Voluntary Contributions and Charges 2017

Dear Parents,

The Carine Primary School Board has endorsed our schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2017. The schedule is broken into 2 sections to allow you to calculate all costs that may be incurred throughout the school year.

### 1. Charges – Compulsory

Our charges schedule shows the costs associated with special programs, excursions and other optional activities. The amounts shown are the maximum charges for scheduled activities throughout the year. There are two types of charges: charges for Educational Activities and charges for Specific Programs

### Charges – Extra Cost Options

Each child will be engaged in a variety of activities associated with educational programs (e.g. excursions, visits, swimming) Charges for these programs vary from year group to year group depending on the nature and range of activities undertaken.

## **2. School Voluntary Contribution**

The total amount of contribution parents/caregivers are being asked to pay is set at \$60 per student which is in line with the School Education Regulation 2000.

Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure in the curriculum learning areas. While the contributions are voluntary the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each Family makes its contribution to the cost of supplement funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth Governments.

### **NOTES:**

- The amounts collected for charges vary from year level to year level depending on the nature and range of optional activities undertaken. Students only incur a cost when they are involved in a particular activity. The estimated amounts indicated for each year level (K-6) represent the maximum amounts anticipated being charged for activities. Very few students in a year level participate in the full range of activities available. Selected students participate in Instrumental music and PEAC.
- Personal items and school uniforms have not been included in the schedule. All uniform items are available from the school's uniform shop.
- Details in the table are based on the amounts paid by parents and receipted by the school over the last several years.
- Additional optional costs for photos may include family, choir, faction captains and councillor photos.
