### **Term 3 2019**

#### **School Finance Report**

66% of families have now paid Voluntary Contributions. The Qkr app is working well and parent feedback is positive.

#### **The Business Plan 2019-2022**

The Board reviewed and commented on the draft 2019-2022 Business Plan which has been developed from the 2019 School Review feedback, system priorities and best practice. The Business Plan will be released shortly to the school community when finalised.

#### **NAPLAN**

The 2019 NAPLAN results have just become available and CPS students made pleasing gains in most areas, particularly in the Year 3 Literacy where students performed well in both Reading and Grammar and Punctuation. The staff participation in the Seven Steps to Writing PL can be considered a contributing factor in the improvement of students' Writing. In Numeracy, the Year 5s are plateauing and the Year 3 progress is trending upward. Students will receive their results shortly.

#### **Contributions and Charges 2020**

Due to increased costs associated with bus hire, it has been necessary to increase charges in the area of Year 3 Interschool Sport by \$10.00 and 5/6 Interschool Sport by \$20.00. The Contributions and Charges for 2020 were endorsed by the Board.

#### **Personal Items Lists**

Board members were provided with a draft copy of the 2020 Personal Items Lists and in most cases, the amount is less than for 2019. Recorders have been added onto the Year 4 list so that these can be purchased directly rather than through the Music Specialist as in the past. The Board endorsed the changes to the Personal Items Lists for 2020.

#### **Enrolments/ Staffing 2020**

Staffing for 2020 is currently being reviewed with proposed enrolments at 590 students and enrolments will be kept to in boundary.

#### **Carine Network Update**

Board members were informed the Board that Carine SHS Principal, Damien Shuttleworth is currently in a temporary role at Padbury Education Services. Across the district, a number of changes will take place with Principals accepting new positions. The Board was provided with an overview of the Minister of Education and Director General's insights and priorities and key agenda items for WA Education.
