## (Children born between I July 2019 to 30 June 2020)

Applications to enrol children entering Kindergarten in the 2024 school year are available online at <u>www.carineprimary.wa.edu.au</u> under the Enrolment tab. If you live in the local intake area for Carine PS the 4-page Enrolment Form needs to be completed and returned, along with proof of address, birth certificate, immunisation records and if applicable, passport with visa and health information. If you live outside of the local intake area the 1page Application Form needs to be completed with the above documentation. Apply by Fri 21 July 2023.

*Note: Current Carine PS Pre-Primary students do not need to re-apply.*
