

# Carine Primary School Schedule of Contributions and Charges 2025



**The Carine Primary School Board has approved this schedule of Charges Summary for 2025.**

**The schedule is broken into sections and will allow you to calculate all costs that may be incurred throughout the year.**

**The Voluntary Contribution remains at \$60.00 per student.**

**The costs outlined for Charges are maximums that the school will not exceed. Actual costs for most parents/guardians will be well below these figures.**



## 2025 School Costs

There are four areas to consider:

<p><b>PERSONAL ITEMS – School Requirements</b> The amount for personal use items will vary from year to year and include student requirements for use in lessons eg stationery items, calculator etc</p>	<p><b>Vary according to the items purchased – paid at the time of ordering.</b></p> <p><i>Please note: Top-ups of stationery items may be required during the year.</i></p>
<p><b>PERSONAL ITEMS – Other Services</b> Graduation T-Shirts, Yearbook, School Photographs etc.</p>	<p><b>Vary according to the items purchased and paid at the time of the activity.</b></p>
<p><b>SCHOOL CONTRIBUTIONS – Voluntary</b> Funds collected will be used by the school to supplement school expenditure in the curriculum learning areas. While the contributions are voluntary the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family makes its contribution - expanding on the funding gained from other sources including the State and Federal Governments.</p>	<p><b>Payments are voluntary - may be paid at the time of ordering Personal Items Lists, via QKR, bank transfer, cash or EFTPOS.</b></p>
<p><b>CHARGES - Extra Cost Optional Components</b> The schedule includes costs associated with specific learning activities for students but conditional on payment being made eg: School Visits, Excursions, In-term Swimming, School Sport Activities, Interschool Sport, Camp, PEAC, Instrumental Music, Choir, Graduation Dinner etc</p>	<p><b>Vary according to the activities. Paid at the time the activity is organised.</b></p>

Students can choose from a range of approximately 50 courses per round of varying cost.</p>
<p><b>Instrumental Music Charge:</b> (Identified students only)</p>	<p>Purchase of own instrument or if applicable, a charge of \$110.00 per year for hire of selected instruments.</p>

### PERSONAL ITEMS – School Requirements:

The school Personal Items Requirements lists cover consumable, stationery type items that your child will need in class - occasionally top-ups may be required throughout the year. You are welcome to purchase the items on the School Personal Items Requirement list at any retail outlet of your choice, however, we do offer the convenience of pre-ordering and delivery to home through our School Board endorsed supplier, Champion Education. The following table gives the maximum costing for each year group.

**Please note** – many of the items listed may be available for reuse from the previous year such as pencil cases, scissors, calculators, USBs, headphones, magnetic whiteboards etc are all items that could possibly be reused.

## CHARGES:

Throughout the year there will be charges that vary from class to class and child to child. Based upon history, the school sets a maximum that is not to be exceeded for that year. (Excursions, Visits, Drama, Swimming, Dance, Carnivals, IT, Camps, etc.) The **maximums** for 2025 are set out below. The amounts encompass all *possible charges* that **could** eventuate, however, in most cases the real costs will be significantly less. Charges are billed at the time of the activity and spread over the four terms.

School uniforms have not been included in the schedule. All uniform items are available from the school's uniform shop. Additional optional costs for photos may include family, choir, faction captains and councillor photos.

Parents are invited to contact Administration to arrange payment plans if at any time you have trouble meeting these costs.

The release of this information is aimed at providing parents with the opportunity to plan ahead to meet the needs of their child/ren's education.
