NEW SCHOOL INFORMATION System

The Education Department is transitioning to a new information system for schools. Called Kaartdijin in WA, (meaning knowledge in the Noongar language) and powered by the Compass school management system across Australia, this will replace the current system.

Parents will be sent an SMS on their mobile phone (with the ID CarinePS) if their child is absent from school without an explanation. Use the link, valid for 48 hours, to reply and add a reason for the child's absence.

Please delete the old Absentee SMS number from your phone to avoid confusion as this will no longer be used.

Until the school starts using a new Compass APP, you can contact the school regarding a student absence via email (carine.ps@education.wa.edu.au), CONNECT or phone (08 9378 5600).

If you don't have the Qkr! APP, please add to your phone, Ipad or computer.

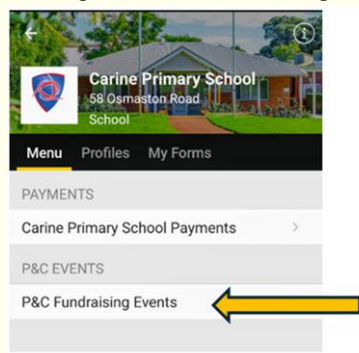
This means you will be able to purchase multiple events, for multiple children in one transaction, without having to preload funds or pay transaction fees.

Carine Primary School Schedule of Contributions and Charges 2026



The Carine Primary School Board has approved this schedule of Charges Summary for 2026.

The schedule is broken into sections and will allow you to calculate all costs that may be incurred throughout the year.

The Voluntary Contribution remains at \$60.00 per student.

The costs outlined for Charges are maximums that the school will not exceed. Actual costs for most parents/guardians will be well below these figures.



PERSONAL ITEMS – School Requirements:

The school Personal Items Requirements lists cover consumable, stationery type items that your child will need in class - occasionally top-ups may be required throughout the year. You are welcome to purchase the items on the School Personal Items Requirement list at any retail outlet of your choice; however, we do offer the convenience of pre-ordering and delivery to home through our School Board endorsed supplier, Campion Education. The following table gives the maximum costing for each year group.

Please note – many of the items listed may be available for reuse from the previous year such as pencil cases, scissors, calculators, USBs, headphones, magnetic whiteboards etc are all items that could possibly be reused.

2026 School Costs

SCHOOL CONTRIBUTIONS – Voluntary Funds collected will be used by the school to supplement school expenditure in the curriculum learning areas. While the contributions are voluntary the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family makes its contribution - expanding on the funding gained from other sources including the State and Federal Governments. CHARGES:

Throughout the year there will be charges that vary from class to class and child to child. Based upon history, the school sets a maximum that is not to be exceeded for that year. (Excursions, Visits, Drama, Swimming, Dance, Carnivals, IT, Camps, etc.) The **maximums** for 2026 are set out below. The amounts encompass all possible charges that could eventuate, however, in most cases the real costs will be significantly less. Charges are billed at the time of the activity and spread over the four terms.

School uniforms have not been included in the schedule. All uniform items are available from the school's uniform shop. Additional optional costs for photos may include family, choir, faction captains and councillor photos.

Parents are invited to contact Administration to arrange payment plans if at any time you have trouble meeting these costs.

The release of this information is aimed at providing parents with the opportunity to forward plan to meet the needs of their child/ren's education.
