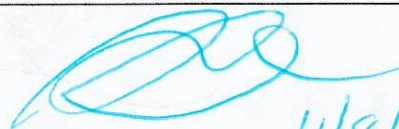
1. Welcome by Chair Sam Daniel welcomed the attendees to the meeting.	S Daniel

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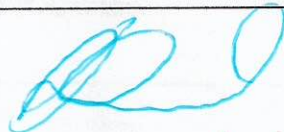
