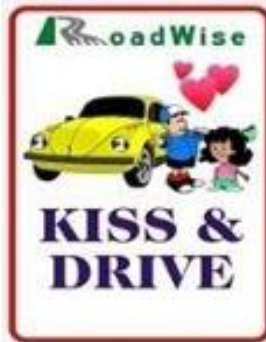
Ordering during the school year

Carine Primary School



There are 6 bays on Osmaston Road at the front of the school operating as designated Kiss & Drive car bays, especially set aside ONLY for drop off and pick up of students before and after school.

- Parents **MUST** remain in the car
- Children exit or enter the car from the **LEFT** side.
- If your child needs assistance with seatbelts, the Kiss and Drive area is **NOT** for you. Park your car **OUTSIDE** of the Kiss & Drive area to collect your children.

Teach your child to get in and out of the vehicle as quickly as possible to consider all users of the zone.

HOW TO USE KISS & DRIVE

1. Move as far forward as possible
2. If you are Car #1 and your **child is not in line ready for collection**, you need to leave the position, drive forward around the roundabouts and join the back of the queue on Osmaston Rd.
3. Car #2 will then move up to position #1. **If your child is not in line ready for collection**, you need to leave the position, drive forward around the roundabouts and join the back of the queue on Osmaston Rd.

This is a continuous flow process.



IMPORTANT

- Only enter the Kiss & Drive zone if you can **SEE** your child is ready to be picked up
- If you cannot see your child, drive around the roundabouts on Osmaston Road and re-join the queue.
- When you enter a Kiss & Drive bay, remain in the car with your engine running and handbrake on.
- **DO NOT get out of your car OR leave your car unattended in the Kiss & Drive zone.**
- Remember to **INDICATE** right when you are ready to re-enter the traffic flow.

Please help everyone to safely use the Kiss and Drive and all other parking around our school correctly.

The City of Stirling rangers will periodically patrol the area. Thank you for your cooperation.
