The school holidays run from 4 July until the 19 July. School recommences on **Monday 20 July**. We wish everyone a safe and enjoyable break.

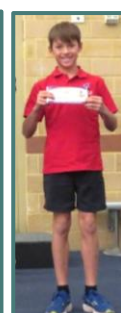

Hello everyone,

As we come to the end of my first term as the School Chaplain at Carine Primary School, I thought I would take the opportunity to introduce myself and share a little about myself and my role in the school community.

Over the past term, I have enjoyed getting to know many of our wonderful students, staff and families. Whether through classroom visits, conversations in the library, special activities, or simply saying hello around the school, it has been a joy to begin becoming part of our school community.

A little bit about me: when I'm not at school, I enjoy singing and playing piano, going for walks in the park and playing board games with my sister. I've also learned two important life lessons: I cannot keep plants alive and listening is often more important than having the right answers.

Many people wonder what a school chaplain does, so I thought I would share a little about that here.

YouthCARE Chaplains are here to listen and provide a supportive place for students to talk. We offer confidential, non-judgemental pastoral care and programs based on hope, respect, compassion, and service.

A chaplain works to create a safe space by listening with empathy, supporting wellbeing programs and referring students to additional help when needed. We also help run and support programs that promote wellbeing and contribute to a positive school culture.

A chaplain connects with students, parents and staff to be a trusted and steady support in times of need. Confidentiality is an important part of pastoral care.

However, if there is a concern that a student may be at risk of harm to themselves or others, this will be shared with the relevant school admin staff, in accordance with admin staff, in accordance with Department of Education and YouthCARE policies and procedures.

One of my favourite parts of this role is seeing students grow in confidence and watching the ways they support and encourage one another.

Thank you for making me feel so welcome during my first term at Carine Primary School. I look forward to getting to know even more students and families throughout the year. I hope you all have a lovely winter break.
