


## **Public School Review**

## CARS - BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL - KISS & DRIVE

At this time of the year, it is worth reminding our community (and informing new families) about the procedures around the Kiss and Drive drop-off and pick-up on Osmaston Road. The bays painted with large white markings adjacent to the staff car park are reserved for pick up and drop off only. Attached is an information sheet describing how the Kiss and Drive works and I **urge** all parents to read it carefully as it is important that everyone follows the rules for the process to work effectively. It is also **essential that parents inform grandparents or afterschool carers** who occasionally do the pick-up, of these rules as they do not receive these notifications.

Please do not choose to use the Kiss and Drive if:-

- Your children are not old enough to get in and out the car without assistance. This includes putting on seatbelts or restraints.
- You need to leave your car. (The kiss and drive area is therefore unsuitable for Kindy and Pre-primary parents who need to collect children from the classroom door.)
- There is no space for you to enter. The information sheet outlines the procedure when this occurs.

To assist with this last dot point, **please move forward** when the bay in front becomes vacant. Carine PS, like all schools, experiences congestion at pick-up and drop-off times. We ask that people follow the guidelines and to remain patient and courteous. It is also important to remember that primary-aged children can be unpredictable around roads. We ask that everyone keep student safety at the forefront of their minds when driving around the school.

Recently, cars have parked on the **verges and across the school driveway**. This is not to occur as it is dangerous and adds to the congestion. The City of Stirling rangers patrol the whole school area and will issue fines for road usage violations.
