Kiss and Drive CAR bays

Do you use the Kiss and Drive before or after school? We regularly publish the rules for the use of the Kiss and Drive in newsletters and on Connect yet we still regularly have people leaving their vehicles in the Kiss and Drive while they walk their children into school or collect them. If your children require escorting into school or need to be picked up from the classroom door the Kiss and Drive is not for you!! People who leave their cars cause great congestion and inconvenience. This puts our students at risk. Please, park in other bays if you need to leave your car. Smart Watches and Phones

Parents and students are reminded that there are strict rules around phones and smart watches at schools. These rules apply to all schools and are governed by legislation.

- While in the school grounds, the use of mobile phones by students is not allowed and phones must be turned off, kept in the student's bag. Phones can be used only after leaving the school grounds.
- Smart watches can be worn but must be placed in Aeroplane Mode or School Mode while at school so that messages and phone calls cannot be received during school hours. Children wearing these devices are agreeing not to alter settings during the school day and understand that consequences, in line with our behaviour policy, will apply for breaching the policy.

We thank parents for their ongoing support in this matter.

Times Table Challenge

Next term, we are beginning a new initiative to encourage students improve their speed and accuracy with their multiplication and division tables. Children in Years 3-6 will have the opportunity to work through different levels and receive achievement badges along the way. Further information can be found later in this newsletter. Scooters & bikes are not permitted to be ridden in the school grounds.

CARS - BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL BAYS ON OSMASTON ROAD

Kiss and Drive carpark bays drop-off and pick-up procedures on Osmaston Road Carine, outside the school.

The bays painted with large white diagonal markings are reserved for student **PICK UP & DROP OFF ONLY. STAY in your CAR - DO NOT LEAVE YOUR CAR.**

Please **DO NOT** use BEFORE & AFTER school pick up bays:-

- If your children are not old enough to exit or enter the car without your assistance = **DO NOT USE the CAR BAYS** – including putting on seatbelts or restraints
- If you need to leave your car = **DO NOT USE the CAR BAYS** – for example Kindy, Pre-primary, Year 1 parents who need to drop off or collect children from the classroom door
- If there is no space for you to enter = **DO NOT USE the CAR BAYS**. You need to drive via roundabouts on Osmaston Rd until there is a car space available. **Move forward** when the bay in front becomes vacant.
- **DO NOT park on the community verges OR across the school driveway.**

The City of Stirling rangers patrol the whole school area and will issue fines for road usage violations.

Please follow the parking rules and remain patient and courteous. Remember that primary-aged children can be unpredictable around roads so please drive safely around our school. **Please tell grandparents, friends** etc who may use car bays of the rules.
