Times Table Badges Challenge

Blue Badge, you need to know your 0x, 2x, 3x, 5x and 10x tables (up to 12x10) There are 60 questions, and you have 3 minutes.

Bronze Badge, you need to know your 2x, 3x, 4x, 5x, 10x and 11x tables (to 12x11) There are 60 questions, and you have 3 minutes.

Silver Badge, you need to know your 2x, 3x, 4x, 5x, 6x, 7x, 8x and 9x tables (to 12x9) There are 100 questions, and you have 5 minutes.

Gold Badge, you need to know your 2x - 12x tables including division
There are 100 questions, and you have 5 minutes.
You must achieve **95% accuracy** in all tests to be awarded your badge.

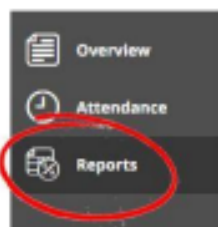

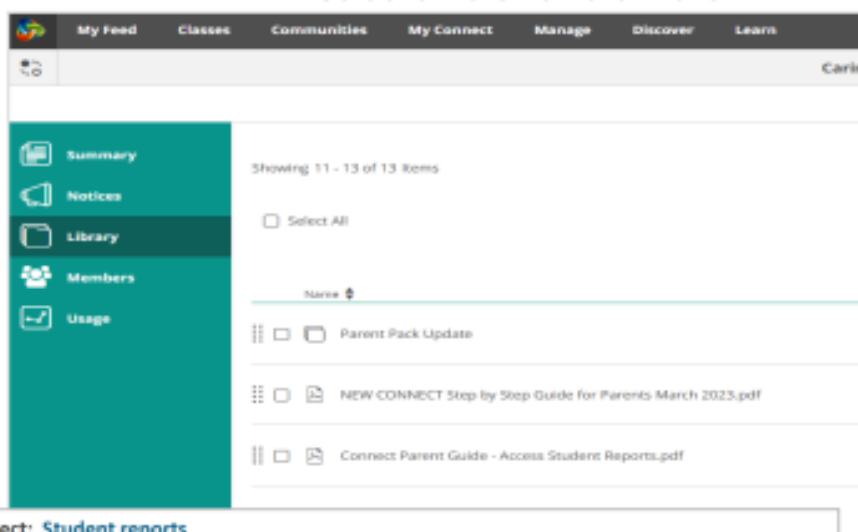

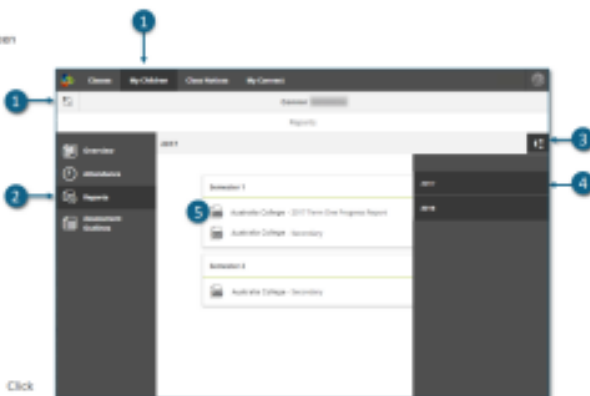
