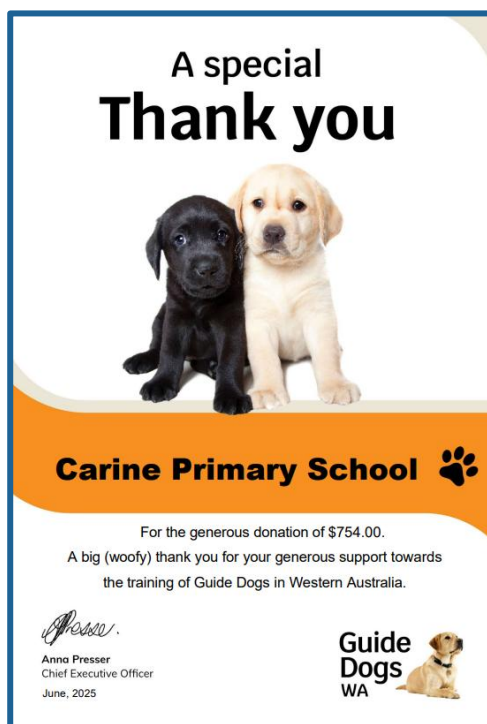
NEW SCHOOL INFORMATION System

The Education Department is transitioning to a new information system for schools. Called Kaartdijin in WA, (meaning knowledge in the Noongar language) and powered by the Compass school management system across Australia, this will replace the current system.

Parents will be sent an SMS on their mobile phone (with the ID CarinePS) if their child is absent from school without an explanation. Use the link, valid for 48 hours, to reply and add a reason for the child's absence.

Please delete the old Absentee SMS number from your phone to avoid confusion as this will no longer be used.

Until the school starts using a new Compass APP, you can contact the school regarding a student absence via email (carine.ps@education.wa.edu.au), CONNECT or phone (08 9378 5600).

If you don't have the Qkr! APP, please add to your phone, Ipad or computer.

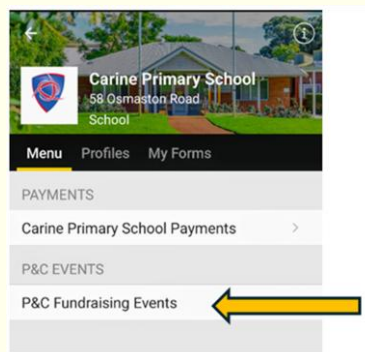
This means you will be able to purchase multiple events, for multiple children in one transaction, without having to preload funds or pay transaction fees.

Please be aware that all fundraising events will be advertised with a **strict order by date** and will be removed from Qkr after this.

We would appreciate your understanding as we try to make this transition as easy as possible.

When using the Qkr APP please remember:

1. On the Menu tab under the P&C EVENTS heading select P&C Fundraising Events



2. Select the Event (e.g. Casino Royale Parent Event)
3. Add to the Cart
4. Sign the Online Permission (*where applicable*)
5. CHECKOUT to make payment.
6. SUBMIT payment

Who can enrol

To ensure a fair and equitable opportunity for all children to enjoy VacSwim, enrolment is limited to one program per child. This means:

- One enrolment permitted for October programs.
- One enrolment permitted for summer programs (December and January).

Families can register on a waitlist for additional programs if desired.

When enrolments open and close

Enrolments are now open.

October enrolments close Tuesday 26 August 2025.

Summer enrolments close Wednesday 15 October 2025.
