Students have been tasked with selecting and researching a Baronga, as well as interviewing a local Elder to gain a richer understanding of Noongar stories, traditions, and connections to Country.

Even more excitingly, **Noongar Radio will be broadcasting live from Carine Primary School on Thursday 4 December from 10.00am to 12.00pm.** We invite our school community to tune in to 100.9FM to hear our students share their learning, voices, and reflections as part of this special cultural event.

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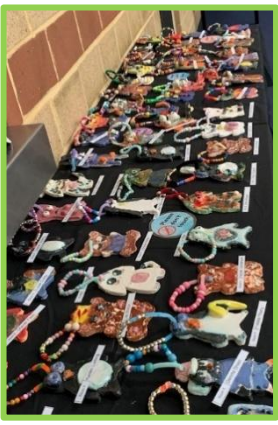
